

**INDEPENDENT REGISTERED MUNICIPAL ADVISOR REPRESENTATION
FOR CARBON-FREE POWER PROJECT**

Pursuant to paragraph (d)(3)(vi)(B) of Rule 15Ba1-1 (the “*Municipal Advisor Rule*”) of the Securities and Exchange Commission (the “*SEC*”) under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended (the “*Act*”), Utah Associated Municipal Power Systems (“*UAMPS*”) hereby represents that, effective August 21, 2020, it is represented by, and will rely on the advice of, PFM LLC (the “*Advisor*”) on all matters relating to Issuances of Municipal Securities for UAMPS’ Carbon-Free Power Project (the “*CFPP*”). For purposes of this representation, “will rely” means that UAMPS will seek and consider, but may not necessarily follow, the advice of the Advisor. Please note that (i) the Advisor’s engagement does not include advice on Municipal Financial Products and (ii) the representation set forth above is accordingly limited.

UAMPS has been advised by the Advisor that it is registered as a municipal advisor with the SEC and the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board. Capitalized terms used and not defined in this representation have the meanings assigned to them in the Act, the Municipal Advisor Rule and the related guidance of the SEC’s Office of Municipal Securities. This representation will continue in effect until an updated representation is publicly posted by UAMPS to its website.
