4. Schedule

The base schedule for this position is four ten-hour shifts, Monday through Friday, every week. This schedule can be modified to accommodate any of the UAMPS operation and maintenance schedules. This includes working 12-hour shifts, days, nights, weekends, and holidays.

5. Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide operational / maintenance staff relief to staff as needed.
- Exhibit strong familiarity with all safety and environmental procedures, programs, and policies. Fulfill duties as specified therein.
- Maintains qualifications to serve as a Nebo Control Room Operator as defined in SOP # JD-02
- Maintains qualifications to serve as a Nebo Field Operator as defined in SOP # JD-01 / JD-01.1
- Serve along with plant management as the Nebo Site Safety Coordinator as defined in SOP # JD-04
- Performs plant operations, preventative, corrective, and predictive maintenance as assigned.
- Provide feedback to plant management on safety and environmental procedures, programs, and policies, which will assist in future revisions and increase their effectiveness.
- Provide training on how to operate and maintain facilities safely as required.
- Provide training on performing water treatment testing and analysis as required.
- Assist operators on shift with solving operational and maintenance problems as they arise.
- In cooperation with staff on shift, detects mechanical or electrical problems and submits work requests for the repair of these problems. If items cannot be repaired or solved.
- Assist the I&C Technician in performing maintenance and upgrade projects.
- Assist with inventory management as required.
- Works overtime as required to maintain operational staffing and to assist in maintenance and/or outages.
- Assist with project documentation control.
- Continues to train and learn in both self-directed and classroom training programs.
- Other duties as assigned.

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6. Supervisory Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide supervision and coordination of personnel as directed.
- Provides supervision to contractors, visitors, and vendors.
- Other supervisory responsibilities may be assigned.
